INFORMATION

Foyer George Williams, part of the Christian Unions Center of Geneva, welcomes young men and women (trainees, university and non-university students) between the ages of 18 and 35.

The Foyer is located in the Junction area, a district close to the Old Town and the university (Uni-Mail).

Reception opening hours

Monday-Friday: **from 8.30 am to 12.30 pm and 5:30 to 8:30 pm**

Saturday: from **6.00 pm to 8.00 pm.**

Closed on Sunday

Price

Long-term lets (more than 3 months): 660.- Swiss francs per month

Stay from 7 days to 3 months: 35.- Swiss francs per day

This set price is for a single room, with all charges included (heating, hot water, electricity, weekly cleaning of the room, bed change linen) and fitness subscription.

Room

Each room includes:

- 1 bed with duvet (Linen includes)
- 1 desk and chair, and a desk light
- 1 wardrobe
- 1 sink
- 1 bathroom cabinet
- 1 balcony

Communal and sanitary areas

For 104 rooms, the Foyer provides:

- 4 communal kitchens with locked fridge compartments and cupboards
- 1 laundry room
- 14 toilets, 13 showers, 3 bathrooms
- 1 lounge room (bar...)
- 1 hot and cold drinks vending machines

Kitchen

Each resident must bring his/her own kitchen utensils. Cooking plates, an oven, a microwave, a sink and a work surface are available in each kitchen.

Laundry

Four washing machines and two dryers are available for residents' use. Residents should book times prior to using the laundry. A card which is CHF 40. - value is available at the reception for the washing machine. The dryer can be used free of charge.

Maintenance of rooms and communal areas

Residents tidy their own rooms and make their own beds. The rooms are being **cleaned weekly** and **every 2 weeks linen are changed**. Residents have to take off the dirty sheets and put them next to their bed. Residents must make their rooms available for the cleaners to enter. Residents have to keep their rooms clean so that the cleaning staff can properly do his job, namely vacuuming etc.

Please note: It is strictly forbidden to put nails or make holes in the walls and to bring other furniture than which are included in the room (desk, bed, chair and wardrobe). The balcony should stay empty,

Entertainment

The Foyer organizes its own activities together with residents. The Christian Unions Centre offers: a theatre "Le Caveau", a restaurant "Le Cazar".

Visits

Visits are allowed between 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.

Absences

The reception must be notified of any absences from the Foyer of more than 7 days.
